(Romans 12:13, 15)

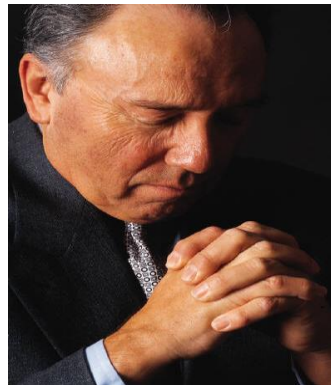


CURRENT PASTORAL CARE MINISTRIES
